

#### Supplementary information for Master of Professional Psychology

#### Guidance for the applicant

- Entry into the Master of Professional Psychology program is highly competitive.
- · Completion of the minimum requirements does not guarantee entry to the program.
- Short listed applicants are normally required to attend an interview in late November/early December as part of the selection process. Being short listed is not a guarantee of entry to the program.
- Please ensure that your formal application to the ANU is accompanied by this form and the following items:
  - 1. Supplementary form
  - 2. Application form (please complete online application)
  - 3. Academic transcripts and testamurs (scanned official and in colour, certified copies in colour)
  - 4. Curriculum vitae (up to date)
  - English Language Proficiency: all applicants whether domestic or international, must provide evidence that their English language ability meets the minimum requirements for admission. The English <u>Language Requirements for Students policy</u> outlines approved methods for meeting the English requirements.
  - 6. Personal Statement: All applicants to submit 200-300 word support statement outlining why you wish to undertake a program of study in professional psychology at the ANU. You can use the section 8 of this form or upload a separate document with your application.
  - 7. Australian Psychological Society qualification assessment (APS assessment): For more information about the **APS qualification assessment** please visit the website: http://www.psychology.org.au/membership/qualifications/
    - \*Please note: the APS assessment can take approximately 2 months and is relevant for internationally qualified applicants only.
  - 8. 2 x referee forms. Applicants may download the Referee Form. Completed referee forms should be sent to ANU directly by your referees via email. Alternatively, you can opt to access the Australian Psychology Post-Graduate Program Reference Request System offered by Psychology Reference. This system is the same across all Australian universities. To be able to use the system, each applicant will need to have an active subscription in the year of application. The cost is \$25 and can be paid for through the 'My Account' section in the payment tab.
