Entry into the clinical psychology program is highly competitive.

Please ensure that your formal application to the ANU is accompanied by this form and the following items:

- 1. Supplementary form including personal statement: (personal statement: 200-300 word support statement outlining why you wish to undertake a program of study in clinical psychology at the ANU).
- 2. <u>Application form</u> (please complete online application) or Domestic applicants apply via UAC.
- 3. Academic transcripts and testamurs (scanned official and in colour, certified copies in colour)
- 4. Curriculum Vitae (up to date) Please ensure dates and whether activities were full time or part time are clearly indicated.
- 5. English language proficiency: all applicants whether domestic or international, must provide evidence that their English language ability meets the minimum requirements for admission. The English Language Requirements for Students policy outlines approved methods for meeting the English requirements. Please note that Eligibility for provisional registration as a psychologist with the Psychology Board of Australia is a condition of entry into the Clinical Program. Due to this requirement applicants must therefore provide evidence of meeting the English language proficiency requirements for AHPRA and the Psychology Board of Australia. - 8. Research Proposal: **PhD applicants** are to submit details of proposed research study and secure a potential supervisor before submitting their applications. (*Master of Clinical Psychology applicants do not need to submit details of their proposed research. Only successful applicants will need to secure a potential supervisor.*)

* Completion of the minimum requirements does not guarantee entry to the program.
